

DANKO JONES Highlights

General

- Atom Willard (The Offspring, Social Distortion, Rocket From The Crypt, Angels & Airwaves) just joined Danko Jones as their new drummer.
- The “Full of Regret” video features Elijah Wood, Selma Blair, Lemmy (Motorhead) and Mike Watt (Minutemen, The Stooges etc). Huge exposure – MTVu/MTV2 premiere, MTVu Rotation, MTV Buzzworthy and MTV Frame By Frame features, Fuse TV “video of the day”, Spin.com feature etc.
- The latest video for “I Think Bad Thoughts” features Elijah Wood, Ralph Macchio, Jena Malone & Mike Watt. Big features on Billboard, Fuse TV, The Wrap, MSN, AOL and countless other sites.
- The video for “First Date” has more than 1,8 million views on YouTube. “Full of Regret” is already at 600,000.
- True Blood named ep 4 of the current season after the Danko track “I’m Alive And On Fire” and the song was also used during the end credits! Rolling Stone feature: bit.ly/dankorollingstone

USA

- “I Think Bad Thoughts” peaked at #33 in the Active Rock charts. Airplay, research and phones are still very strong at numerous stations.
- Played 15-20 radio shows/festivals on this record already. Another handful confirmed in Aug/Sep. Did 20+ radio interviews in combination with their performance at Rock on the Range.
- Reissued “Below The Belt” on June 21:st with bonus tracks + video trilogy. Features on Revolver, Guitar World, Artist Direct and AOL in the week of release + interview with Rockline and it was also LA Lloyd’s “pick of the week”.

Canada

- “Full of Regret” was one of the most played rock songs on Canadian radio in 2010! 34 weeks (!!) in the top 20 in the Active Rock charts, peaked at #5. Top 20 in the Alternative charts.
- Toured Canada with Guns N’Roses and Nickelback. Opened up for The Rolling Stones.
- Recently sold out the Commodore in Vancouver in advance (1,050 tickets). Biggest Canadian tour in years.

Europe

- “Below The Belt” charted in Germany (top 30), Sweden (top 10), Norway, Finland, Switzerland, Austria and The Netherlands.
- Toured 9 European countries with Guns N’Roses in 2010. Have previously toured Europe with Motorhead for 6 weeks. Huge profile in Europe. Sold out headline shows across the continent. Up to 2,000 cap venues. Played basically all the biggest festivals in Europe.
